The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in FIR No.30 dated 24.02.2016, registered under Sections 420, 494, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Division No.4, Ludhiana.

Heard.

On 12.04.2016, the following order was passed:-

“On oral request, the petitioner is permitted to implead the complainant as respondent-party. Amended memo of parties be filed and thereafter notice of motion be issued, returnable for 19.07.2016.

Mr. N.S. Lucky, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if she is sought to be

arrested, she shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer subject to the conditions laid down in section 438 sub section 2 clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure”

The petitioner is the mother-in-law of the complainant. Vide judgment/order of even date, passed in CRM-M-15960-2016, which shall form part of this order, co-accused/husband Vijay Mahajan and complainant-wife Sonika have reached to a settlement and ad interim bail granted to the former has been made absolute.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.04.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
