LISA GILL, J.

This petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 15 dated 22.03.2016 registered under Sections 323,406,498-A and 506 of the IPC at Police Station Women, MDC, Panchkula.

It is submitted that during pendency of this petition, the parties have amicably resolved the entire dispute between them. The terms and conditions of the settlement have been drawn up today itself i.e. 15.03.2017. The affidavit of the petitioner as well as the complainant/respondent No.2 produced in Court today are taken on record subject to just exceptions. The detailed terms and conditions of the settlement between the parties find mention in the said affidavits. It is submitted that both the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement.

It is affirmed by the learned counsel for the State that the petitioner has joined investigation. There is no allegation on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond or dissuade the witnesses in any manner.

In view of the facts and circumstances as above, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequentially order dated 12.04.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute.
