Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for safeguarding/protecting life and personal liberty of the petitioner from being invaded by respondents No.4 to 6.

Petitioner alleges that in the year 1992, respondents No.4 and 5 purchased the plot in question from one Chela Shah in which rasta was shown towards western side of the plot. Respondents No.4 and 5 thereafter sold the plot in question to respondent No.6 by showing the rasta towards northern side. Respondent No.6 further sold the plot to the petitioner by showing the existence of rasta towards northern side vide sale deed dated 07.09.2010.

Allegations have been made that respondents No.4 to 6 in connivance with the police are involved in harassing the petitioner in respect of use of rasta in question for which a representation has already been filed by the petitioner before respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Ripudaman, A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, in view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing any reply to the petition as no order prejudicial to interest of any of the party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take lawful action on the complaint/representation of the petitioner if cognizable offence is found to have been committed. If no worth is found in the complaint/representation of the petitioner, then he may be communicated about the outcome in view of parameters as laid down in **Lalita Kumari v. Govt. of U.P. (2014) 2 SCC (1).**
