In this petition, the petitioners are seeking protection of life and liberty at the hands of respondents no.4 to 8 as the petitioners are stated to have married with each other against the wishes of the said respondents.

Despite notice having been issued and interim protection granted to the petitioners, as per the report of the Registry, notices actually could not be issued as even the process fee was not filed by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Today none has appeared for the petitioners.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents no.2 & 3 to continue to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is duly protected within the four corners of the law.

However, it is made clear that in case any of the averments made in this petition are found to be false, this order shall not be treated as a bar on any action taken as per law against the petitioners or the private

respondents.
