The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.149 dated 28.03.2016 for the offence under Sections304-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Bahadurgarh.

The petitioner is in custody from 16.04.2016. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nachatter Singh submits that after framing of charges 19 witnesses have to be examined and the suicide note has not been sent to the handwriting expert and no sample was given by the complainant. The death of the deceased took place in her parental house.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that appeal is not likely to mature in near future, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Jhajjar.
