Heard.

A complaint was received in the jail by the Administrative Judge during jail inspection. It comes out that the trial is pending against the petitioner. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harbans Singh, PS Bikhi has stated that so far as 9 witnesses have been examined and 8 witnesses are yet to be examined. He has undertaken that the trial will be concluded within three months by producing the remaining witnesses.

In the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the trial Court to dispose of the trial within three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order by granting short adjournments. The State is directed to ensure that all the summoned witnesses shall come present in the Court on the said date. In case of default, the concerned SHO shall be held responsible. So far as bail is

concerned, let the petitioner move an appropriate application before the concerned Court stating the grounds on which bail is sought for.

The present petition stands disposed of.
