This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.103 dated 14.09.2016, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station, Ajitwal, District Moga.

The petitioner is in custody since 14.06.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the marriage of petitioner was solemnized with the deceased about 08 years back. Two sons were born out of this wedlock. He further states that as per medical opinion, cause of death was on account of hanging.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed the Court that after presentation of challan, the trial is fixed for 04.05.2017 for consideration on charge.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this

petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular

bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial
Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga.
