Petitioners-Harvinder Singh alias Ganja and Tejpal Singh alias Sona have filed this 2nd petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in cross-case registered vide DDR No.18 dated 30.09.2016, under Sections 307, 341, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered in case FIR No.133 dated 20.08.2016, at Police Station Kamboj Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned State counsel stated that till now, no injury has been declared dangerous to life. It is a case of cross-version. The injury has been declared simple provisionally.

The petitioners have been in custody since 03.01.2017. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the fact that it is yet to be determined by the trial Court on the basis of evidence as to who is the aggressor party, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
