By invoking Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short "Cr.P.C."), the present petition has been filed for issuance of direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to conduct enquiry and take appropriate action, in accordance with law, against respondent Nos. 4 to 8 and others for cognizable offences committed by them and further directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from respondent Nos. 4 to 8.

Perusal of the averments set up in the petition would clearly indicate that the present petition is an effort in an indirect manner to seek intervention of this Court for registration of FIR against the private respondents and thereafter investigation on the basis thereof.

The controversy raised in the present petition is squarely covered by the judgment of this Court **Jaswinder Kaur vs. State of Punjab, 2014(1) R.C.R.(Criminal) 569.**

Disposed of in the same terms.
