Learned counsel for the petitioners, as also for the State, on instructions from HC Daljit Singh, submits that the statements of the petitioners have been recorded by the police of Police Station, Lopoke, Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar, as also of one Amarjit Singh who is the brother-in-law of petitioner No.1, and of a maternal uncle, to the effect that the matter has been amicably settled and the petitioners are no longer under any threat.

Learned counsel for the State also submits that in fact the father of petitioner No.1, i.e. respondent No.4, has died and her mother, i.e. respondent No.5, is also unfortunately bedridden.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to continue to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is duly protected, within the four corners of law.
