The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 not to harass the petitioners in FIR No.116, dated 18.07.2016, under Sections 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

It is contended that the alleged recovery of 37 bags of poppy husk (each weighing 35 kgs.) was effected from two other co-accused and not from the present petitioners. Further contended that the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been presented before the Court below on 06.01.2017 qua two other co-accused from whom the alleged recovery has been effected.

During the course of arguments, it has been conceded by the counsel appearing for the petitioners that till date even the application to secure the concession of pre-arrest bail has not been filed. Apparently, inspite of the petitioners having been named in the disclosure statement of the main accused and from whom the alleged recovery has been effected, they have not joined investigation.

The pleadings and averments made in the present petition as regards harassment of the petitioners do not inspire any confidence.

Accordingly, no directions are required to be passed in the present petition

Petition is dismissed.
