SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioners, who are the accused persons in FIR No.6 dated 07.01.2017 under Sections 380, 384 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') and Section 66 of the I.T. Act, 2000 (Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station City Phagwara City, District Kapurthala, have prayed for quashing of FIR with all subsequent proceedings pending in the Court of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phagwara.

During pendency of the trial, the complainant has arrived at a settlement with the accused persons vide compromise Annexure P-2, which is duly signed by him. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The SDJM,

Phagwara vide report dated 29.04.2017 apprising this Court that the

compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure and that no accused is proclaimed offender out of two accused involved in the present case.

Respondent No.2 is represented by her counsel.

In view of the report of SDJM, Phagwara and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543* and *Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending since the complainant has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioners/accused persons.

In the circumstances, these petitions are allowed. FIR No.6 dated 07.01.2017 under Sections 380, 384 & 120-B of IPC and Section 66 of the I.T. Act, 2000 (Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 & 471 IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station City Phagwara City, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
