Present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.35 dated 18.02.2017 under Sections 295, 380, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326/324 IPC added lateron) registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has since joined the investigation and no useful purpose would be served by detaining him in custody and he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant contended that main injuries attracting Section 326 IPC are attributed to the present petitioner. More so, the weapon of offence used for commission of offence is yet to be recovered. There is no ground for releasing the petitioner on pre-arrest bail.

Since the allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature and recovery of weapon used during the commission of offence is yet to be effected and for that purpose custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required. No ground for enlarging the petitioner on anticipatory bail is made out. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
