This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent Nos. 4 to 8.

Grievance of the petitioner is that she is married with Paramjit Singh-respondent No.4. Two children were born out of this wedlock. Her husband is a daily drunkard and use to beat her. On 27.02.2017, she was made to leave her matrimonial house. Thereafter, she started residing separately at Hoshiarpur. However, her husband and his family members are continuously harassing her. In this regard, she has made a representation dated 30.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

At this stage, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur-respondent No.1 to look into the representation dated 30.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
