Petitioner-Niranjan Nangia has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing the order dated 28.11.2014 and the order dated 30.01.2015 vide which non-bailable warrants were issued against the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner only presses the relief that interim order dated 20.04.2015 whereby the petitioner was directed to appear before the appellate court and on doing so, he was ordered to be admitted to interim bail, be made absolute.
