Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.62 dated 27.11.2016 registered under Sections 379-B, 341, 506, 427 and 323 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala the petitioner is being prosecuted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel for respondent No.4-complainant state that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties. This Court had directed the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate vide order dated February 28, 2017 to record the statements of the parties in view of the compromise, only after depositing non refundable costs by the petitioner in the sum of ₹10,000/- with the

office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala and verify that whether the same is genuine or not. Now, there is a report received from the District & Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur showing that in compliance of order dated February 28, 2017 made by this Court ₹10,000/- as non refundable costs has been deposited by the petitioner with the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala and the statements of the parties have been recorded and compromise that has been arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

Looking to the nature of the offences registered in the FIR, I think, parties should be allowed to compound/compromise the offences in order to live in peace and harmony.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.62 dated 27.11.2016 registered under Sections 379-B, 341, 506, 427 and 323 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala is by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
