The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.220 dated 19.10.2016 registered under Sections 452, 341, 324, 323 and 326 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Shahkot, Jalandhar.

On 07.04.2017 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Contends that initially the FIR was registered under Sections 452, 341, 324, 323 read with Section 34 of IPC. After the investigation, Section 452 of IPC stands deleted. The injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature and on non vital parts.

Notice of motion for 09.05.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject

to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 07.04.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 07.04.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
