Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 20, dated 25.02.2016, registered under Sections 427, 380, 506, 447 and 448 IPC, at Police Station Ramdas, Amritsar.

Vide order dated 29.04.2016, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer.

Seeking anticipatory bail, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated on account of the family rivalry as the complainant is related to the petitioner; there is no other criminal case pending against him and under the interim orders of this Court, he has joined investigation and fully cooperated with the police.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kulbir Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and at this stage is not needed by the investigating agency for any further questioning.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 29.04.2016 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
