By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.88, dated 18.03.2015, registered under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sadar Tohana, Distt. Fatehabad.

On 07.04.2017, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was not involved in the process of sale and purchase of articles taken by Sarpanch and the other members of the the Gram Panchayat. Ramesh Kumar, who is the Sarpanch, had made a statement in CRM-M-5621-2017 that to show his bona fide he would be willing to pay the entire embezzled amount.

Notice of motion for 17.05.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1.That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2.That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3.That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 07.04.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
