On 07.04.2017 following order was passed by this

Court:-

"In order to show the bona fide of the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to pay a sum of Rs.4,00,000/- to the complainant without prejudice to his rights in ultimate decision of the case.

Notice of motion for 29.05.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to deposit an amount of Rs.4,00,000/- to the Investigating Officer by way of demand draft in the name of the

complainant within a period of one week from today.

In the event of deposit of the aforesaid amount, the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer shall enlarge the petitioner on interim bail, subject to his satisfaction. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Today learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Kumar stated that pursuant to the aforesaid order, demand draft No.001463 dated 15.04.2017 in a sum of Rs.4 lacs has been received by the Investigating Officer from the petitioner, which is in the name of the complainant Baljit Singh. The demand draft in original has been produced, which has been handed over to the learned counsel for the complainant. Photocopy of the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is ready to pay remaining amount of Rs.3.5 lacs in two installments.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the interim order dated 07.04.2017 is made absolute.

Let the first installment to the tune of Rs.2 lacs be paid to the complainant by way of demand draft on 30.06.2017 and the second installment in respect of remaining amount of Rs.1.5 lacs be paid to him by way of demand draft on 30.07.2017. The demand drafts shall be routed through the Investigating Officer.

If the aforesaid amount is not paid, then this order will be of no consequence.

Petition stands disposed of.
