Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No. 133, dated 25.12.2014, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985, registered at Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur.

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that the trial is at the fag end as only the two official witnesses remain to be examined and that the State would examine them on the next date of hearing subject to the petitioner's cooperation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the bail application, at this stage, with liberty to approach this Court again for the grant of regular bail in case the State does not conclude the trial in terms of the above statement suffered by learned State counsel.

Dismissed as not pressed with liberty as prayed for.
