This petition for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner has been filed in criminal case bearing First Information Report No.128 dated 20.09.2016, under Sections 22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar, Patiala, District Patiala. The petitioner-Angrej Singh @ Geja was arrested on 20.09.2016 and is in jail since then.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The allegation against the petitioner-Angrej Singh @ Geja is that he was found in possession of 60 grams of intoxicant powder containing Diphenoxilate Hydrochloride salt without any licence or permit.

Learned State counsel has stated that no other case is stated to be pending against the petitioner under NDPS Act.

The trial will take its own time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars any more. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, this petition is accepted. The

petitioner-Angrej Singh @ Geja is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrare/Duty Magistrate concerned subject to an undertaking on affidavit that he would not indulge in similar or any other kind of offence in future. The petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence or influence the prosecution witnesses.
