In compliance with the order dated 28.04.2017, affidavit of Sh. Sushil Kumar, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib dated 02.05.2017 has been filed in Court. Along with the said affidavit, affidavit of petitioner No. 1-Meenu Rani dated 29.04.2017 and that of petitioner No. 2-Sukhwinder Singh also dated 29.04.2017 have been filed. Statement of Prem Babu son of Mani Ram-respondent No. 4, father of petitioner No. 1 Meenu Rani has also been appended.

On the basis of these affidavits and the statement of Prem Babu, the Senior Superintendent of Police has concluded that no protection/security is required by the petitioners regarding the life and liberty from the private respondents. It has further been stated that the

security will be provided to them as and when they require the same.
