The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 83 dated 04.10.2015 registered under Sections 4, 5 and 19 of Punjab Land Preservation Act and under Sections 186 and 353 of IPC at Police Station Kiratpur Sahib, District Ropar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner had been allotted 5 marlas in Khasra No. 929/248 vide resolution No. 2 dated 20.12.2007 by Gram Panchayat of Village Kalyanpur. Her husband had constructed a house on the allotted land in the year 2007 and since then they have been residing therein. He further contends that there is no basis to suggest that they have carried out any construction on the land owned by the Forest Department. He also contends that earlier on an inquiry conducted by Deputy Inspector General of Police, the allegations made against the petitioner were found to be false.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 10.04.2017 had directed the petitioner to join investigation. Interim bail was also granted to her.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu on instructions

from ASI Naresh Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and she

is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, the order dated 10.04.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and she shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged by Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
