Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not appeared despite being intimated. On behalf of the State, it is stated that inquiry was conducted into the allegations regarding alleged murder of Karnail Singh by private respondents and that Karnail Singh appears to have died after consuming excessive intoxicants on the night of 21.2.2016. Dead body of Karnail Singh was cremated without informing the police and no post-mortem was done. Petitioner approached the police station only on 22.2.2016. Police inquired into the matter and found that Karnail Singh died due to consumption of excessive intoxicant drugs. Therefore, no action could be taken.

Since, dead body of Karnail Singh was cremated without informing the police and without conducting the post-mortem and there is no prima-facie evidence regarding murder of Karnail Singh, as coming out from the police inquiry, the present petition stands dismissed.
