On 26.04.2016, interim directions were issued and the petitioner was allowed to join the investigation. Thereafter, some payments were made by the petitioner and vide order dated 02.03.2017, a consensus was arrived at between the parties whereby petitioner was required to pay Rs.35 lacs in two installments each without prejudice to the rights of the parties at the relevant time.

Admittedly, an amount of Rs.35 lacs has been

deposited by the petitioner with the Bank.

In view of above, interim order dated 26.04.2016 is hereby made absolute without prejudice to the rival claims of the parties to be decided at the relevant stage in appropriate form.

Petition stands disposed of.
