Petitioner, who is a lady aged about 25 years has filed the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents for protection of her life and liberty.

As per averments made in the petition, petitioner was married on 18.7.2010 to Sunil Kumar son of Satish Kumar/respondent no.9. Two children are stated to have been born out of the wedlock. It is her case that her husband is a drug addict and she is being beaten up and harassed by her husband as also by her in-laws.

As per pleadings on record, the petitioner under such circumstances having gone back to her parental home, even her parents and maternal uncles are forcing her to abandon her husband as also matrimonial home and want her to get married to an aged person, who is residing in Italy.

Counsel submits that the petitioner is running from pillar to post and is presently taking shelter in the house of a family friend in Mohali.

Counsel argues that the petitioner faces apprehension and threat to her life and liberty not only from her in-laws but also from her parents.

Without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the present petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach S.H.O., Police Station, Doraha, District Ludhiana with a representation as regards her grievance.

In the eventuality of any such representation being preferred, S.H.O., Police Station, Doraha, District Ludhiana would be obligated to examine the same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of.
