DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioners seek the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 32, dated 29.04.2016, registered under Sections 308, 382, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 18.01.2017, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer and shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C.

Seeking anticipatory bail for the petitioners, learned counsel submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case; Section 308 IPC has been deleted by the police and under the interim order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation and have fully cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Mann Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined investigation; have fully cooperated with the investigating agency and at this stage are not needed for further questioning by the investigating agency.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 18.01.2017 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.

During the period that the bail is granted to the petitioners, if they are found indulging in any criminal/illegal activity or misusing the concession of bail granted by this Court, it would be open to the State to move an appropriate application before the competent Court/this Court for cancellation of the bail granted to the petitioners.
