Petitioner-Sahil Garg has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.122 dated 28.04.2016, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that earlier, the petitioner was granted

interim bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Mohali. However, he

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absented from the court proceedings on 03.04.2017; his interim bail order was cancelled and his non-bailable warrants were issued.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 07.04.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that at this stage, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in this petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 07.04.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute and the interim bail granted to the petitioner by the trial Court vide order dated 26.05.2016 shall remain to continue till 07.07.2017 i.e. date given by the trial Court, which shall deal with the bail application of the petitioner after receiving the report of FSL.
