TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.225, dated 29.08.2012, under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Pleadings on record would indicate that even though the petitioner had been granted concession of regular bail vide order dated 17.11.2012 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge (Special Court), Tarn Taran, yet such concession was misused and the petitioner having absented from trial proceedings was declared as proclaimed offender on 24.10.2015. Petitioner thereafter is stated to have surrendered and has been in custody since 24.08.2016.

Custody certificate furnished by the learned State counsel would indicate that apart from the present FIR, petitioner is involved in three other cases under the NDPS Act as also yet another FIR for offence under Sections 306/34 IPC.

Looking towards the conduct of the petitioner as also his

antecedents as disclosed in the custody certificate, the benefit of regular bail is denied to him.

Petition is dismissed.
