This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, whose bail has been cancelled and non-bailable warrants issued for his failure to appear before the trial Court on 31.01.2017.

The petitioner is an accused in case FIR No. 85 dated 21.3.2016, under sections 147, 149, 395, 447, 448, 456, 457, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt.

After framing of charges in the aforesaid case against the petitioner, the case was adjourned to 16.11.2016 for prosecution evidence and thereafter to 30.11.2016 and lastly to 05.01.2017. As 05.01.2017 was declared to be a holiday, the case was taken up on 4.1.2017 and adjourned to 13.01.2017 and then to 31.01.2017. The petitioner was not present in Court on 31.01.2017, the learned trial Court cancelled his bail and warrants of arrest issued for 23.02.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been appearing before the trial court on every date and it was due to wrong date noted by him, he was absent on 31.01.2017. He further states that his absence was not intentional. The next date fixed in this case is 18.04.2017.

In view of the above,the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on or before 18.04.2017 and on his doing so, the Trial Court shall admit him to bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction.
