The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.17 dated 25.02.2017, registered under Section 376(1) of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Women, Bhiwani.

Heard.

On 19.07.2017, the following order was passed:-

*“Contends that the complainant caused injuries upon the petitioner on 25.02.2017 at 4.00 p.m. The petitioner was hospitalized on the same day at 6.30 p.m. The prosecutrix is a married lady aged 40 years. It is asserted that no such incident took place. In fact, the present FIR is a counter blast to the FIR No. 94 dated 26.02.2017 registered by the petitioner for the injuries suffered by him.*

*Post again on 22.08.2017.*

*The petitioner is directed to join the investigation.*

*Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject*

*to the following conditions:-*

- 1.That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2.That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
- 3.That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 19.07.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
