Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.122 dated 19.12.2016 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Lahori Gate, Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case and he is not the main accused rather the injuries were caused by Kulwinder Singh and allegations against the present petitioner are of catching hold of the injured person. More so, the petitioner is in custody since 28.12.2016 and decision of the case still to take some more time. So he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant contended that injuries in the case are under Section 307 IPC also and with active participation of the present petitioner, Satbir Sharma

caught hold Harwinder Singh alias Happy and the injuries were caused with the intention to commit murder of Kulwinder Singh with knife blows and as such, he does not deserve the concession of bail.

Having considered the submission made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 28.12.2016 and no injury attributed to the present petitioner rather the allegations against present petitioner is of catching hold of the deceased only. Decision of the case still to take some more time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, therefore, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate, Patiala.

The petition stands allowed.
