The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.134 dated 02.08.2015 under Sections 147, 148, 364, 452, 302 and 201 IPC, registered at Police Station Ateli, District Mahendergarh.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ved Parkash would not dispute the fact that the present petitioner would be on a similar footing as co-accused Ashok Kumar @ Kalia and who has been granted the benefit of regular bail vide order dated 27.03.2017 in CRM-M-9519 of 2017.

State counsel would further point out that the period of incarceration suffered by Ashok Kumar co-accused was since 23.09.2015 whereas the present petitioner has been in custody since 04.07.2016.

Be that as it may, the present petitioner for the same

very reasoning as furnished in order dated 27.03.2017 passed by this Court in CRM-M-9519 of 2017, is held entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Narnaul.
