On the basis of an application submitted by petitioner Prem Singh son of Gurbachan Singh, who is confined in Central Jail, Amritsar, the present petition was numbered. In the application, the petitioner has made a prayer that his daughter, valuables and money may be retrieved from his wife, namely, Gurjit Kaur. He has an apprehension that his daughter might be killed by Gurjit Kaur.

On notice of motion having been issued, reply by way of affidavit of Ashwani Kumar, PPS, DSP, Sub-Division Patti, District Tarn Taran has been filed. As per the reply, detailed enquiry was conducted in the matter by SHO, Police Station Patti City through ASI Sarabjit Singh and in the enquiry, it was found that the allegations levelled by the petitioner are

false and baseless. Komalpreet Kaur @ Jasmanpreet Kaur, who is minor daughter of the petitioner, is living happily with her mother Gurjit Kaur in the house of Salwinder Singh @ Shinda Singh at village Lakhna as they have no other source of their food etc. Said Salwinder Singh @ Shinda Singh is nursing Komalpreet Kaur @ Jasmanpreet Kaur and her mother Gurjit Kaur. Even during enquiry, Gram Panchayat of village Lakhna, Block Valtoha has also produced a joint Panchayat Nama in favour of Gurjit Kaur, Balwinder Kaur and Salwinder Singh @ Shinda Singh, wherein the Panchayat has stated that Gurjit Kaur and Balwinder Kaur are residing in village Lakhna happily with their own consent and sweet will.

In view of the above, this Court finds that the application for registration of an FIR submitted by the petitioner is nothing but a frivolous one. Accordingly, the present petition, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
