Present writ petition is by workman-Darshan Singh seeking regularization from the date i.e. January 1994 when his juniors Kashmira Singh, Harbans Singh and Farjand Khan's services have been made regular. He claims to be in service since 1976. The case file indicates that his services were terminated on 9.8.1990 and he was ordered to be reinstated with continuity of service and full back wages by virtue of the ex parte award dated 26.8.1993 passed by Labour Court, Patiala. The counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-Department denies that the petitioner was in service since 1976 and has also pointed out that there is no document on record that he had been working since 1976. Notice issued to the petitioner has not been received back, served or otherwise. However, his counsel states that they do not have any contact with their client.

In the aforesaid circumstances, we consider it appropriate at this stage to order consignment of the case to record-room with liberty to the parties, to get the case revived in accordance with law, if circumstances so exist.
