Petitioner alleges violation of his civil rights at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in the year 2003, two FIRs were registered against the petitioner and his family members in which they were acquitted, but still the private respondents are all out to diminish the image of the petitioner before the society.

Petitioner claims himself to be the elected member of the Gram Panchayat. At this stage, no final opinion of any fact can be made, however for the protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioner, pending representation dated 31.03.2017 moved by the petitioner before respondent Nos.2 &

3 can be considered by the authorities concerned.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. P.S. Ghuman, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage.

In view of nature of prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to decide the pending representation moved by the petitioner without being influenced by any of the pleadings or observations made in the preceding paras.

Let a necessary decision be taken by respondent No.2 within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
