The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.6 to consider the pending representation dated 03.01.2017 without being influenced by any of the pleadings and observations made in the preceding paras.

Let a necessary decision be taken by respondent No.6 within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
