The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest, who have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. vide order dated 08.02.2017 in FIR No.61 dated 28.09.2016.

It is argued that the petitioners herein were not named in the FIR and no specific role has been attributed to them. It is contended that the petitioners are falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation. It is submitted that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioners have

joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 12.04.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
