INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Parminder Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.23 dated 04.03.2017, registered at Police Station Rahon, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 420, 406, 465, 468 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that the petitioner is named in the FIR. The specific allegations have been levelled that payment of ₹25 lakhs was paid to the present petitioner etc.

Learned State counsel has brought into notice of this Court that three more FIRs have already been registered against the present petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
