HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioners are tenants of house owned by respondent No.6. Their grievance is that respondent No.4 in collusion with respondent Nos.5 and 6 are pressuring them to vacate the premises in their possession. He states that respondent No.4 has been repeatedly calling the petitioners and threatening them to vacate the premises. On 03.04.2017, the petitioner No.2 was illegally detained at the Police Station B-Division, Amritsar, by respondent No.4. He was made to spend 24 hours in illegal custody and made to sign on the numerous blank papers. Respondent No.4 has also allegedly threatened them and give them ultimatum to vacate the aforesaid property by 11.04.2017. The petitioners had submitted a representation dated 31.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2 requesting that respondent No.4 be restrained from harassing them illegally, but without any result.

In view of the aforesaid, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, i.e., Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into the representation dated 31.03.2017 (Annexure P-2), in accordance with law.
