Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0002 dated 10.02.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station NRI, Amritsar.

This Court vide order dated 05.05.2017, while adjourning the case for 18.07.2017, has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation on 11.05.2017, but on the adjourned date i.e. 18.07.2017, it was stated by learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, that the petitioner is not cooperating with the Investigating Officer. Accordingly, vide order dated 18.07.2017, petitioner was again directed to appear before the

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to aforesaid orders dated 05.05.2017 and 18.07.2017, petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Naresh Kumar, has stated that in terms of above orders, petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide orders dated 05.05.2017 and 18.07.2017 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
