This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.84, dated 08.03.2017 under Sections 458, 380, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Focal Point, District Ludhiana City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 11.04.2017, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Nirmal Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the said fact, present petition is allowed and the order passed by this Court dated 11.04.2017, is made absolute subject to the conditions mentioned below, as envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C :-

1. He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and
3. He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
