Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In cross case No.034 dated 27.02.2017, under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 326 IPC added later on) in FIR No.0017 dated 26.02.2017, under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail. This Court had made an order dated 11.04.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Head Constable Kuldeep Singh states that pursuant to the said order, the petitioner has joined investigation and custody is not required.

In that view of the mater, interim order dated 11.04.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
