The petitioners are seeking concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.11, dated 25.02.2017, registered under Sections 457, 380, 447 and 511 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Affidavit of the Investigating Officer has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

As per averments made in the affidavit, neither the face of any assailant could not be identified nor the registration numbers of the vehicles are clearly visible in the CCTV footage.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already joined the investigation and no more required for further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh, who has filed the aforesaid affidavit, submits that the petitioners have filed an application before the DSP Nakodar for further investigation of the case and the same is still pending.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is

disposed of and the order dated 12.04.2017 is made absolute subject to the conditions as prescribed under Sections 438 (2) Cr.P.C..

However, It is made clear that in case the petitioners fail to appear before the Investigating Officer on any subsequent date in pursuance to a written notice to them, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail.
