Short reply by way of affidavit of Ravinder Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Meham, Rohtak, filed on behalf of the State, in Court today, is ordered to be taken on record. Copy of the same has been handed over to counsel opposite.

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioners to which they apprehend danger on account of having got married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 9, who are the relatives of petitioner No.1.

The earlier orders passed by this Court show that on 11.04.2017 to ensure the petitioners' safety they were directed to be lodged in a protection home of the Chandigarh Administration.

As per the afore-referred affidavit filed on behalf of the State, in Court today, the police have recorded the statements of respondents No.4 to 9 to the effect that they have no objection to the petitioners' marriage.

In view of the above statements made by respondents No.4 to 9 to the police, learned counsel for the petitioners, at this stage, does not press the present petition. Accordingly, the petitioners need not to be kept in the protection home at Chandigarh any longer and are free to go to their matrimonial home.

However, it is clarified that in future in case the petitioners feel threatened at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9 they may make a representation to respondent No.3 who is directed to forthwith act on the same in accordance with law to ensure their safety and security.

The petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
