The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. raising a prayer for grant of interim bail for a period of 15 days to the petitioner so as to facilitate his participation in the 'Bhog Ceremony' of his mother-in-law who is stated to have expired on 16.03.2017.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner and having perused the pleadings on record, this Court is not inclined to extend the concession that has been prayed for.

It is beyond dispute that the petitioner is the main accused in FIR No. 19 dated 18.01.21015, under Sections 302, 307, 452, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.

The precise allegation against the petitioner is of having murdered his brother-in-law, namely, Jaswinder Singh. The 'Bhog Ceremony' slated for 16.04.2017 is of the mother of Jaswinder Singh (deceased).

In my considered view, the concession, as prayed for, if granted would only vitiate the atmosphere at the 'Bhog Ceremony'.

Prayer is declined.

Petition dismissed.
