The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.112 dated 21.07.2016 under Sections 307/323/34 registered at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 24.04.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Mohinderpal, states that in pursuance to the order dated 24.04.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 24.04.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
