The aforementioned appeals were filed by
complainant-M/s The Star Wire India Ltd., 21/4, Mathura Road,

Ballabgarh, Haryana through its Manager Shri K.P.Singh for challenging the judgment dated 15.9.1999 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridabad whereby the accused/respondent, namely, Shri T.P.Singh Kalra, Director M/s Orion Auto & Steel Industries Pvt.
