The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking bail in case FIR No.82 dated 24th May, 2016, registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC and further added Sections 307 and 326 IPC at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

It is submitted by learned Counsel for the State on instructions from HC Sukhdev Singh, that the weapon referred to in the previous order passed on 25th May, 2017 has since been recovered, and that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

As such, the matter is disposed off by confirming the bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14th April, 2017.
